- Cardiac Cath
- Previous Abnormal EKG/Stress test

Neurology Clearance

History of:

- Stroke/TIA
- Seizures
- Aneurysm

Hematology Clearance

History of:

- Any type of bleeding/clotting disorder
- Lupus

Nephrology Clearance

History of:

- Dialysis
- Renal failure
